# Day Excursions

## Ambleside & Bowness

A mile inland from the northern tip of Windermere lakeshore, Ambleside is a bustling town of outdoor equipment shops, bookshops, gift shops, cafes and restaurants. Nestled in the valley between various fells, it's the start and end point for many classic lake land walks. The Lake District's most popular destination, Bowness-on-Windermere is busy for most of the year. People come to enjoy the lake for sailing and water sports or just relax and enjoy the atmosphere of the area and the towns delightful setting.



## Bakewell & Buxton

Bakewell is a historic market town in the heart of England's Peak District, famous for its scenic beauty, independent shops, and traditional treats, especially the Bakewell Pudding and Tart, a confection accidentally invented at the Rutland Arms Hotel. Visitors explore its riverside charm, ancient stone buildings and weekly market. Buxton is definitely worth visiting, especially if you love history, stunning architecture, natural beauty, and spa town charm, serving as a great gateway to the Peak District for walks and exploring. It offers unique attractions like thermal spas (Buxton Crescent Hotel), ancient caves (Poole's Cavern), beautiful gardens (Pavilion Gardens), Georgian/Victorian buildings, and independent shops.



## Beamish (Including Entrance)

An early start this morning as we make our way north to Beamish where we spend the day. Beamish is a world-famous open-air museum, telling the story of life in North East England during the 1820's, 1900's and 1940's. Highlights include 1900s Town, 1900s Pit Village, 1940s Farm and Rowley Station. Step 'behind the scenes' into the Open Store and see some fascinating objects stored in the collections. Get a real taste of the past, catering outlets across the site serve traditional tasty treats, from homemade hot meals to delicious snacks, cakes and drinks.



## Beaumaris

Take a walk through the town, starting with a stroll along the sea-front, taking in the pier and the views over the Menai Strait and Snowdonia, then continuing through charming streets with their picturesque cottages. Beaumaris has lively cafés, pubs and restaurants and some excellent shopping marked by quality independent traders.



## Beverley

With it's awe-inspiring Minister, historical buildings, cobbled streets and small town charm there is something for everyone in Beverley. An up-market shopping experience amongst cobbled streets and courtyards with many high street names. In addition there is an interesting selection of smaller independent shops, an antique arcade and the Saturday Market is delightful for a weekend browse.

## Bridgewater Gardens

RHS Garden Bridgewater offers 154 acres of glorious gardens set in Salford's historic landscape. This inspiring oasis continues to evolve with help from award-winning designers and the local community. After a lush greeting from the Worsley Welcome Garden, step inside the walls of the Paradise Garden and admire the awe-inspiring blend of Mediterranean and Asiatic planting. Then treat your senses to the abundant Kitchen Garden, or follow the winding paths of the Chinese Streamside Garden. And for the young at heart, no visit could be complete without exploring the natural play areas, set within the shaded woodland.



## Boundary Outlet, Banny's & Illuminations

First stop today is Boundary Outlet for a spot of retail therapy. Grab a big-name brand at a bargain price before heading off to Banny's Fish & Chip Restaurant where we enjoy a delicious 'Chippy Tea' before we head to Blackpool. See the seaside city of fun still buzzing with excitement and laughter long after other resorts have gone into winter hibernation. At 10 kilometres long and using over one million bulbs, the Blackpool Illuminations are an awesome spectacle.



## Bowland Food Hall & Clitheroe

Bowland Food Hall is a wonderful showcase of the finest, the tastiest, and the healthiest food and drink from producers, farmers and growers from Bowland, Lancashire and beyond. Clitheroe is a bustling centre of well known names and boutique high street gems.



## Great Yorkshire Show (Including Admission)

Join us on one of our most popular day excursions. Set in 250 acres the Great Yorkshire Show is the largest farming and countryside show in England. While the show has agriculture at its heart, there's entertainment, shopping, live music and cookery demonstrations.



## Harrogate/Flower Show

We travel to Harrogate to take in The Harrogate Spring Flower Show. This prestigious event features stunning show garden features, live talks and demonstrations, great garden shopping, and the biggest exhibition by florists and flower arrangers in the country. For those not wanting to visit the flower show the coach will be dropping off in Harrogate.

## Haworth

Haworth is absolutely worth visiting, especially for literature lovers (Brontë fans), history buffs, and those who enjoy charming, historic villages with beautiful countryside walks, offering the Brontë Parsonage Museum, iconic cobbled streets, heritage steam trains, and stunning moorland scenery.



## Hebden Bridge

Hebden Bridge is widely considered worth visiting, especially for those who enjoy quirky independent shops, vibrant cafés/pubs, rich history, and stunning Pennine scenery with excellent walking trails, offering a cool, creative vibe in former mill town surroundings. Its mix of independent retail, outdoor access (like Hardcastle Crags), and unique character makes it a popular Yorkshire destination.



## Keswick

Keswick is situated between the huge bulk of Skiddaw and the gentle beauty of Derwentwater has become the major centre for tourism in the Lake District. The pretty market town offers a wide range of attractions from shops and restaurants to museums with a difference.



## Kettlewell Scarecrow Festival & Skipton

Each year, for one week mid-August, hundreds of scarecrows holiday in the delightful Dales village of Kettlewell. Human visitors try to find them all, solving clues and puzzles as they hunt. The Kettlewell Scarecrow Festival is a great way for the whole family to discover this lovely village in Wharfedale and has now been running for nearly 30 years. There are plenty of refreshments available with three pubs and two cafés as well as places to picnic by the river. The whole event raises money to support local community facilities such as the school and village hall. We finish the day with a couple of hours exploring Skipton.



## Lincoln

Brimming with history and heritage, Lincoln is one of England's finest cities. If you're planning a visit to this hidden gem, you'll find everything you need right here. From the tip of the Cathedral to the depths of the Roman waterways, Lincoln is full of fascinating stories just waiting to be discovered. Lincoln is a destination that everyone can enjoy. With award-winning attractions, great shopping and a wealth of places to eat and drink, this beautiful city makes for the perfect weekend break.

As Lincoln is a compact city, you can easily explore on foot. Start your day with a coffee in the stylish Cornhill Quarter, before hitting the shops on the High Street. After indulging in some retail therapy, you can take a relaxing stroll along the Brayford Waterfront, home to the award-winning University of Lincoln.

## Ormskirk Market & Southport

## Pickering & Helmsley

Pickering is a small town with a wealth of heritage. From William the Conqueror to Oliver Cromwell and Harry Potter, several notable and fictional characters have graced the town of Pickering throughout the years adding to its rich tapestry. We also visit Helmsley, a perfect English market town, with dramatic castle ruins, charming tea rooms and inviting inns.



## Portmeirion (Includes Admission)

Portmeirion Village is well known as the location for the 1960s cult TV series *The Prisoner*. It comprises a cluster of colour-washed buildings around a central piazza, scenic surroundings and extensive woodlands. In addition to its architectural heritage, its stunning setting and sub-tropical gardens, Portmeirion has two stylish hotels, shops, a spa, cafés and restaurants and an authentic Italian style gelateria.



## Ripon

The little city that packs a big punch, Ripon, in Yorkshire is a cathedral city steeped in history and home to magnificent historical buildings and long observed traditions. You will find a trio of award-winning museums and a gothic cathedral that dates back to the 7th century that are waiting to feed our enquiring minds. With a thriving market place, this busy little city will earn a place in any visitor's heart. Reaching out from the market square are small streets and snickets that are home to eclectic and specialist shops for which Ripon is so loved. Amongst them are cafés and pubs, offering refreshment and home cooked food throughout the day.



## Scarborough
